

Greeting and Invocation: We gather today in the love of God, the compassion of Jesus, our Christ, and of the Holy Spirit – \square Amen.



From Psalm 48



Consider well her ramparts, view her citadels, That you may tell of them to the next generation. For this God is our God for ever and ever; God will be our guide even to the end.


