From Psalm 34


I sought God and God answered me; God delivered me from all my fears.

Those who look to God are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame. The poor man called, and God heard him; God saved him out of all his troubles.


The angels of God encamp around those who fear and God delivers them.

Taste and see that God is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in God.


